APPLICATION FOR EXONERATION OF PER CAPITA TAX

In order to be considered for a **temporary exoneration** an individual must complete an application on a yearly basis and meet one of the requirements listed below:

1. A **full time student** as of July 1 of the tax year.
2. An individual **age 62 or older as of July 1 of the tax year and whose total income from all sources is less than \$10,000 annum.** Income sources include: social security, wages, annuity or retirement benefits, rental income, dividends, and interest.
3. An individual serving in the **Military** as of July 1 of the tax year.

In order to be considered for a **permanent exoneration** and individual must meet the following requirement listed below:

1. A **permanent resident in a nursing home** facility as of July 1 of the tax year.

INSTRUCTIONS: Should you meet one of the requirements, complete the questions listed below and attach a copy of supporting documentation pertaining to your exoneration request. Examples are: **a college tuition statement, a Pennsylvania State tax return, a W-2 statement, a Military identification card, or correspondence from a nursing home facility endorsing an individual's permanent residency in the facility.**
